### Village Confines/Village Envelope

#### What is it?

The ‘confines’ would usually include:

- Existing built-up area, excluding open spaces, (rear gardens abutting open countryside; individual or groups of dwellings, nearby farm buildings or other structures not closely related to the main built up area).
- Outside this area, all land is regarded as being open countryside.
- Permission for residential development outside village ‘confines’ will only be granted in exceptional circumstances.

#### How a ‘Village Envelope’ sits with the Local Plan

- It will **NOT** be part of the Local Plan.
- It does **NOT** prevent windfall development.
